## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

### AN ACT CHANGING THE JOB GROUP CLASSIFICATIONS OF CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 683 of the acts of 1960 is hereby  
2 repealed.

1 SECTION 2. The positions of social worker, department of  
2 public welfare, head social worker, department of public wel-  
3 fare, and supervisor of social service, department of public wel-  
4 fare, established as the result of chapter 683 of the acts of  
5 1960, shall be classified under chapter 30, sections 45 through  
6 50 of the General Laws and shall be allocated to the same title  
7 and job group to which the class of social worker, head social  
8 worker and supervisor of social service is allocated in the Gen-  
9 eral Salary Schedule on the effective date of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect as of July 1, 1962.
