AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRUSTEES OF THE BRISTOL COUNTY TUBERCULOSIS HOSPITAL TO HAVE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS PREPARED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A HOSPITAL FOR CHRONIC DISEASES IN THE CITY OF ATTLEBORO.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Trustees of the Bristol County Tuberculosis  
2 Hospital are hereby authorized and directed to cause plans  
3 and specifications to be prepared for the construction of a  
4 hospital for chronic diseases, containing a minimum of one  
5 hundred and twenty-five beds, to be located on Oak Hill  
6 Avenue in the city of Attleboro, at the site of the Bristol  
7 County Hospital. For said purposes, said Trustees may expend  
8 such sums, not exceeding fifty thousand dollars, as may be  
9 provided therefor in the appropriations for the current year  
10 for said county.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
