To The Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:

In accordance with the provisions of Article LVI of the Amendments of the Constitution, I am returning herewith Senate No. 762 entitled "An Act Releasing The Rights Of The Commonwealth In Certain Premises In The Cities Of Boston And Cambridge Below High Water Mark To Leo M. Pistorino".

I recommend that the bill be amended by adding after the word "structures" as it appears as the last word in the second sentence, the following words: "notwithstanding the provisions of section 15 of chapter 91 of the General Laws".

This amendment appears to be necessary in order that there be no conflict with the existing Statutes pertaining to tidewater lands.
