AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WESTFIELD TO PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO HAZEL M. CARDINAL AND EDWARD J. CARDINAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation, the city
2 of Westfield may appropriate and pay to Hazel M. Cardinal
3 and Edward J. Cardinal, former residents of said city, the
4 amount of money expended by them for travel expenses in-
5 curred as a result of incorrect information given to them by
6 the police department of said city that their son, William
7 Cardinal, had been found dead in said city.
