AN ACT PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF CERTAIN RULES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 21 of chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following two sen-
3 tences:— Whoever violates any rule made under authority of
4 this section shall be punished by a fine of one hundred dollars.
5 Each day during which such violation continues shall constitute
6 a separate offense.
