AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING CHARTER SERVICE OR SPECIAL SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The third paragraph of section 11A of chapter 159A of the
- 2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out its third sen-
- 3 tence thereof and inserting in its place the following: —
- 4 The terms of “charter service” or “special service” shall not
- 5 include the transportation of school children to and from school
- 6 pursuant to a written contract with a municipality or municipal
- 7 board or with the authorities of such school; provided, that the
- 8 charges for such transportation are borne by such municipality
- 9 or municipal board or school; and provided, further, that no
- 10 special charges for such transportation are made by the mu-
- 11 nicipality or municipal board of such school on account of the chil-
- 12 dren transported; or the operation of a motor vehicle so used and
- 13 owned and operated by such authorities; or the operation of
- 14 sight-seeing automobiles licensed under chapter three hundred
- 15 and ninety-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-one.
