AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 10 of chapter 118 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in section 1 of chapter 413 of the acts of 1936, is
3 hereby amended by striking out the second sentence and insert-
4 ing in place thereof the following sentence: — No applicant for
5 assistance hereunder, who knowingly makes any false state-
6 ment, or seeks to perpetrate any fraud or deception, in or rela-
7 tive to his application for such assistance, shall be granted any
8 assistance hereunder upon such application.

1 SECTION 2. Section 6 of chapter 118A of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in section 1 of chapter 436 of the acts of 1936, is
3 hereby amended by striking out the third sentence and insert-
4 ing in place thereof the following sentence: — No applicant for
5 assistance hereunder, who knowingly makes any false statement,
6 or seeks to perpetrate any fraud or deception, in or relative to
7 his application for such assistance, shall be granted any assist-
8 ance hereunder upon such application.
