
By Mr. Wojtkowski of Pittsfield, petition of Thomas C. Wojtkowski that compensation for certain services rendered by members of the teachers' retirement system be included in the salary on which retirement deductions are to be paid into the annuity savings fund of said system. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN SERVICES RENDERED BY A MEMBER OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE SALARY ON WHICH DEDUCTIONS ARE TO BE PAID INTO THE ANNUITY SAVINGS FUND OF SAID SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The paragraph defining "Regular compensation" in section 1
2 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
3 ing out the last sentence, as amended by section 2 of chapter
4 516 of the acts of 1957, and inserting in place thereof the fol-
5 lowing sentence: — In the case of a teacher employed in a public
6 day school who is a member of the teachers' retirement system,
7 salary payable under the terms of an annual contract for addi-
8 tional services in such a school and also compensation for serv-
9 ices rendered by said teacher in connection with a school lunch
10 program or for additional services of an educational nature or
11 for services in connection with a program of instruction of phys-
12 ical education and athletic contests as authorized by section
13 forty-seven of chapter seventy-one shall be regarded as regular
14 compensation rather than as bonus or overtime and shall be in-
15 cluded in the salary on which deductions are to be paid to the
16 annuity savings fund of the teachers' retirement system.
