The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN THE CITY OF QUINCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Massachusetts board of regional community
2 colleges is hereby authorized and directed to establish a regional
3 community college in the city of Quincy.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I, Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.
