PROPOSAL FOR A LEGISLATIVE AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION PROVIDING FOR VOTING BY CITIZENS OF EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE AND UPWARDS.

1 A majority of all the members elected to the Senate and House
2 of Representatives, in joint session, hereby declares it to be ex-
3 pedient to alter the Constitution by the adoption of the follow-
4 ing Article of Amendment, to the end that it may become a part
5 of the Constitution [if similarly agreed to in a joint session of
6 the next General Court and approved by the people at the state
7 election next following]:

8 ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT.

9 Article III of the Amendments to the Constitution, as
10 amended, is hereby further amended by striking out, in the first
11 line, the word "twenty-one" and inserting in place thereof, the
12 word: — eighteen.
