AN ACT RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT A SWIMMING POOL IN THE CITY OF MEDFORD ON LAND OWNED BY SAID COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to construct a swimming pool in the city of Med-  
3 ford on land owned by said commission preferably along the  
4 banks of the Mystic river. For the purposes of this act, said  
5 commission may expend such sums as may be appropriated  
6 therefor.
