AN ACT RELATIVE TO HOLIDAY PROVISIONS FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 24A of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by chapter 639 of the acts of 1963, is hereby
3 further amended by adding the following new sentence at the
4 end of said section: — And, further provided, that if any of the
5 holidays referred to herein falls on a Saturday and said Saturday
6 is the regular day off of an employee in a department or institu-
7 tion service which is operated on every day of the calendar week
8 and said employee's usual work week is five or more days, he
9 shall be entitled to an additional day off for such holiday, or
10 payment in lieu of said additional day off, despite the fact that
11 it occurred on a Saturday.
