RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF CONSTRUCTING OR ACQUIRING AN EXECUTIVE MANSION FOR THE USE OF THE GOVERNOR.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 two members of the senate, three members of the house of
3 representatives, and two persons to be appointed by the gov-
4 ernor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an inves-
5 tigation and study relative to the feasibility of constructing or
6 acquiring an executive mansion for the use of the governor.
7 Said commission may travel without the commonwealth.
