RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE MEANS OF PROCURING EDUCATIONAL FILMS FOR PRESCHOOL CHILDREN SUITABLE FOR TELEVISION BROADCASTING, AND THE MEANS OF SECURING THE BROADCASTING THEREOF, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 the commissioner of education, who shall be the chairman, three
3 members of the senate, five members of the house of representa-
4 tives, an attorney to be designated by the attorney general,
5 and five persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby
6 established for the purpose of studying the means of procuring
7 educational films for preschool children, suitable for television
8 broadcasting, and the means of securing the broadcasting thereof.
9 Said commission may travel without the commonwealth.
