AN ACT CHANGING THE FORMULA FOR STATE AID TO CITIES AND TOWNS FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF SCHOOL CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The first paragraph of section 7A of chapter 71 of the General
- 2 Laws, as appearing in chapter 754 of the acts of 1949, is hereby
- 3 amended by striking out, in line 9, the word "five" and insert-
- 4 ing in place thereof the word: — three.
