AN ACT PROHIBITING A LICENSED OPERATOR UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE FROM OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE EXCEPT DURING THE INTERVAL BETWEEN SIX O'CLOCK ANTE MERIDIEM AND EIGHT O'CLOCK POST MERIDIEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 604 of the acts of 1960, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: — Application for license to op-
5 erate motor vehicles may be made by any person; but before
6 such a license is granted the applicant shall pass such examina-
7 tion as to his qualifications as the registrar, without discriminat-
8 ing as to age, shall require, and no license shall be issued until the
9 registrar or his authorized agent is satisfied that the applicant is
10 a proper person to receive it, and no such license shall be issued
11 to any person under sixteen years of age; provided that no
12 person under the age of eighteen years to whom a license has
13 been issued shall operate a motor vehicle on the public ways,
14 except during the interval between six o'clock ante meridiem
15 and eight o'clock post meridiem and an endorsement to this
16 effect shall be printed in red ink on the face of the license of
17 any person under eighteen years of age.
