AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DIVISION OF WATERWAYS, TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN STONE GROINS, JETTIES, OR OTHER SHORE PROTECTIVE DEVICES ALONG THE SHORES OF PLUM ISLAND WITHIN THE CITY OF NEWBURYPORT AND THE TOWN OF NEWBURY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works, division of
2 waterways, is hereby authorized and directed to construct and
3 maintain stone groins, jetties, or other shore protective devices
4 along the shores of Plum island within the city of Newburyport
5 and the town of Newbury. Said department shall utilize all
6 prior studies and surveys made of the storm damage and erosion
7 along with current studies and surveys, and shall expend for the
8 purposes of this act such sums as may be appropriated therefor,
9 but shall not exceed a total of two hundred and fifty thousand
10 dollars. The total costs of any such projects shall be borne by
11 the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
