### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF DOVER TO SUPPLEMENT THE PENSION OF FLORENCE M. SCHAFFNER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the public good  
2 and in order to compensate Florence M. Schaffner for loss of  
3 pension for the month of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-  
4 three, upon her retirement as clerk of the board of assessors and  
5 and as clerk of the board of selectmen and to compensate her  
6 for service as temporary tax collector during the period from  
7 the first day of November, nineteen hundred and sixty-three,  
8 to the second day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-four,  
9 the town of Dover is authorized to pay to the said Florence M.  
10 Schaffner such amount, not exceeding five hundred and twenty-  
11 three dollars, as may be determined by the town by vote adopted  
12 in the manner specified for acceptance of this act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by  
2 the town of Dover by a majority vote at an annual or special  
3 town meeting warned for the purpose before or after the pas-  
4 sage of this act.
