By Mr. Manning of Waltham, petition of the Massachusetts Retired Police and Firefighters Association that provision be made for the payment of pensions to the spouse of a member of the contributory retirement system who has been retired for accidental disability. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO PENSIONS FOR THE SPOUSE OF A MEMBER RETIRED FOR ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Option (b) B of subdivision (2) of section 12 of chapter 32
2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after para-
3 graph (11) the following: paragraph (111) the spouse of any
4 member retired under section seven Accidental Disability Chap-
5 ter as required by section twelve has been pensioned as of
6 Option (b) shall receive a pension of one hundred dollars per
7 month as long as he or she remains unmarried, providing said
8 member had paid in full all contributions required of the con-
9 tributory pension system.
