AN ACT REQUIRING THAT THE HIGHWAY FUND BE USED IN PART TO ASSIST IN COVERING THE DEFICIT OF THE WOODS HOLE, MARTHA'S VINEYARD AND NANTUCKET STEAMSHIP AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized to re-
2 imburse the towns of Falmouth, Tisbury, West Tisbury, Gos-
3 nold, Edgartown, Chilmark, Gay Head and Nantucket for the
4 purpose of assisting in covering the deficit of the Woods Hole,
5 Martha's Vineyard and Nantucket Steamship Authority sub-
6 ject to appropriation.
