AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LAWRENCE TO REIMBURSE FRANCIS G. FOSMIRE FOR CERTAIN TRAVEL AND MOVING EXPENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation, the city of
2 Lawrence, by its mayor and its council, may appropriate and
3 pay to Francis G. Fosmire, superintendent of the Bessie M.
4 Burke Memorial Hospital, a sum not exceeding five hundred
5 and twenty-four dollars and sixty-seven cents to reimburse him
6 for travel and moving expenses incurred by him in the course of
7 being employed by the trustees of said hospital.
