AN ACT TO ALLOW CORPORATIONS TO ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF A MASTER PLUMBER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 142 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by adding the following at the end thereof: — Corporations may
3 engage in the business of a master plumber provided a licensed
4 master plumber is the owner of an unencumbered fifty-one per
5 cent of the controlling certificates of stock of the corporation
6 and provided that the licensed master plumber is an officer of the
7 corporation.
