AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER OF PROBATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 98 of chapter 276 of the General Laws, as amended by
2 section 80 of chapter 801 of the acts of 1963, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the last sentence of the second para-
4 graph and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—
5 The deputy commissioner shall be paid by the commonwealth a
6 salary of thirteen thousand five hundred dollars, and shall devote
7 his full time during business hours to the duties of his office.
