RESOLVE CALLING UPON THE SPECIAL UNPAID COMMISSION ON TAXATION TO STUDY THE TAX NEEDS OF CITIES AND TOWNS FOR SPEEDIER ACTION ON WELFARE AND ALLIED REIMBURSEMENTS.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission on taxation be directed
2 to study the needs of cities and towns for speedier tax reim-
3 bursements in the fields of welfare and other public assistance
4 programs. The said commission is hereby directed to present
5 its report together with any legislation necessary to carry into
6 effect its recommendations to the clerk of the house of repre-
7 sentatives on or before the first Wednesday of December in the
8 current year.
