### AN ACT RELATING TO THE APPORTIONMENT OF TAXES IN EMINENT DOMAIN PROCEEDINGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 79 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 35 thereof the following section: —
- 3 *Section 35A.* In case of a trial by jury in a proceeding brought
- 4 under section fourteen, the amount, if any, to which the peti-
- 5 tioner is entitled by reason of the tax assessed upon the prop-
- 6 erty in the year in which it was taken, as provided in section
- 7 twelve, shall be separately determined by the court, upon
- 8 stipulation of the parties or upon evidence received, after the
- 9 the jury has rendered its verdict.
