By Mr. Quinn of Boston, petition of Joseph K. Collins for legislation to regulate the payment for services performed by retired members of the judiciary. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT REGULATING PAYMENT FOR SERVICES PERFORMED BY RETIRED MEMBERS OF THE JUDICIARY RECEIVING PENSIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 749 of the acts
3 of 1963, is further amended by inserting after the word "year" in
4 the nineteenth line of the first sentence as appearing in said
5 section 2, the words: — or for services as a retired member of
6 the judiciary under the provisions of sections sixty-five D
7 through sixty-five J of this chapter.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July first, nineteen
2 hundred and sixty-four.
