AN ACT TO ESTABLISH PARLIAMENTARY RULES OF ORDER IN TOWN MEETINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 the word "order" in the first sentence of the first paragraph
3 the word: — in conformance to an adopted set of parliamentary
