## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Four.

AN ACT TO ENABLE THE ESSEX COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN ADDITIONAL LAND IN THE CITY OF LAWRENCE FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF LAWRENCE IN SAID COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Essex county are  
2 hereby authorized to acquire by purchase or otherwise from the  
3 Lawrence Redevelopment Authority a certain parcel of land in  
4 the city of Lawrence adjoining the premises of the district court  
5 of Lawrence on the west and containing approximately twenty-  
6 seven hundred square feet for parking purposes and for purposes  
7 of egress and ingress to the present parking area; and for said  
8 purpose said commissioners may expend a sum not exceeding  
9 nine thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its passage.
