AN ACT REQUIRING SIGNS TO BE PLACED ON STREET CORNERS INDICATING THE NAME OF THE STREET OR STREETS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The department of public works, the metropolitan district
- 2 commission and every city and town shall cause to be placed
- 3 at the corner of every street under its jurisdiction a sign bearing
- 4 the name of the street or streets intersecting at such corner.
