AN ACT PROHIBITING THE CANCELLATION OF COMPULSORY MOTOR
VEHICLE LIABILITY POLICIES EXCEPT UNDER CERTAIN CONDI-
TIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 113A of chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after provision (3), as appearing in the
3 Tercentenary Edition, the following provision:—

4 (3)A That, except as provided for in provisions (2)A and (3),
5 the policy cannot be cancelled by the insurer during the term
6 for which it was written for any reason except that the policy
7 was obtained by fraud or false representations made by the in-
8 sured, or nonpayment of premium.
