AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A FENCE ALONG POND BROOK IN THE CITY OF GARDNER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
2 directed to construct and maintain a fence along the open ditch
3 of pond brook between Mechanic street and John street in the
4 city of Gardner. For said purpose the said department may
5 expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

Committee of Education

Report of the Committee

The Committee on Education of the House of Representatives has the honor to report to the House the results of its investigation into the condition of the public schools of the District of Columbia. The report is divided into two parts: the first part contains a general statement of the facts and figures, and the second part contains the recommendations of the Committee. The Committee finds that the public schools of the District of Columbia are in a state of chronic neglect and that the condition of the schools is such as to make it impossible for the children of the District to receive a proper education. The Committee recommends that the Government should take immediate steps to improve the condition of the schools and that the Government should provide the necessary funds to carry out these recommendations.
