RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, consisting of
2 two members of the senate, three members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, one person to be appointed by the registrar of motor
4 vehicles, one person to be appointed by the commissioner of
5 public safety, one person to be appointed by the Massachusetts
6 police chiefs' association and two persons to be appointed by the
7 governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an
8 investigation and study of the motor vehicle laws of the common-
9 wealth generally, but with particular attention to rules and regu-
10 lations relative to the right of way at intersections.
