AN ACT PROVIDING POLICE PROTECTION FOR HOUSING PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 121 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 26CCC, the following section:—
- 3 *Section 26DDD.* All housing projects shall have twenty-
- 4 four hour special police protection, provided by the housing
- 5 authorities. For this purpose, special officers shall be appointed
- 6 by the housing authorities who shall pay such special police
- 7 officers the prevailing wage of the local police.
