AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT A RECREATION CENTER IN THE CITY OF CHELSEA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to construct a recreation center with suitable struc-
- 3 tures and facilities in the city of Chelsea. Said commission may
- 4 expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
