AN ACT PROVIDING LIFE TENURE FOR RICHARD T. SILVER, INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF CITY PURCHASING AGENT OF THE CITY OF LOWELL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of office of Richard T. Silver, incum-
2 bent of the office of purchasing agent of the city of Lowell, shall
3 be unlimited. Said incumbent shall not be removed or sus-
4 pended from office, except for just cause and for reasons specif-
5 ically given him in writing by the city manager in the manner
6 provided by section forty-three of chapter thirty-one of the
7 General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city of Lowell.
