**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Four.

AN ACT PLACING CERTAIN POSITIONS OF THE DIVISION OF MOTORBOATS WITHIN THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES UNDER CIVIL SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 16 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in section 1 of chapter 275 of the acts of 1960, is  
3 hereby amended by striking out the second paragraph and in-  
4 serting in place thereof the following paragraph: —

5 The director may, subject to the provisions of chapter thirty-  
6 one, with the approval of the registrar of motor vehicles, employ  
7 such hearing officers, inspectors and such administrative, tech-  
8 nical, clerical and other employees as in his opinion the duties  
9 of the division may require, and may expend for such purpose  
10 and any other necessary expenses such amounts as may be ap-  
11 propriated therefor out of the recreational boating fund. The  
12 positions and compensation of such employees shall be classified  
13 in accordance with sections forty-five to fifty, inclusive, of chap-  
14 ter thirty.

1 SECTION 2. Any incumbent, upon the effective date of this  
2 act, of an office or position referred to in section one made sub-  
3 ject by the provisions thereof, to the civil service laws and rules,  
4 shall be entitled to be appointed to said office or position under  
5 said laws and rules, upon passing a qualifying examination and  
6 upon certification by the director of civil service, but any incum-

7 bent upon said date of any such position who fails to pass any  
8 such qualifying examination may be continued by the appointing  
9 authority in such office or position for the remainder of the term,  
10 if any, for which he was appointed, but shall not otherwise be  
11 subject to the provisions of the civil service laws and rules.
