AN ACT INCREASING THE COMPENSATION AND TRAVEL ALLOWANCE  
OF JURORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 25 of chapter 262 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the first two sentences and inserting  
3 in place thereof the following:— The compensation of all trav-  
4 erse jurors and of grand jurors shall be fifteen dollars for each  
5 day's service. All jurors shall receive for each day of actual  
6 attendance ten cents a mile for travel out and home, but not  
7 for such time as the jury is held under restraint, by order of  
8 court, at the expense of the county.
