AN ACT CHANGING THE JOB DESIGNATIONS OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES
IN THE DIVISION OF UNIVERSITY EXTENSION IN THE DEPARTMENT
OF EDUCATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary the
2 director of personnel and standardization is authorized and
3 directed to change the designation of the position of supervisor,
4 of which there are ten in number, in the division of university
5 extension in the department of education, so that there shall
6 be five supervisors and five senior supervisors.

By the Committee on Education and the Arts, in response to a resolution of the House of Representatives, passed July 1, 1954.

The Constitution of the United States

In the Year 1787, the United States was organized.

An Act to provide for the organization of the United States, and for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of the Constitution of the United States, approved July 1, 1787.

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the following be and they are hereby enacted into Law.

4. to which there are ten positions, in the division of statistics
5. division in the department of education, so that there shall
6. be two positions and two senior positions.
