## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Four.

### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REORGANIZATION OF THE RECREATION COMMISSION IN THE CITY OF WOBURN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 358 of the acts of 1945 is hereby amended  
2 by striking out section 1 and inserting in place thereof the follow-  
3 ing section:—

4 *Section 1.* A recreation commission, hereinafter referred to  
5 as the commission, is hereby established in the city of Woburn.  
6 The commission shall consist of three persons who shall serve  
7 without compensation. One member shall be appointed by the  
8 mayor of said city, one by the city council thereof and one by  
9 the school committee thereof. The term of service of each  
10 member shall be concurrent with the term of service of the  
11 office of mayor. All members shall serve until the qualifica-  
12 tion of their respective successors. Any vacancy occurring in  
13 the commission shall be filled for the remainder of the term by  
14 the mayor, by the city council or by the school committee ac-  
15 cording as the original appointment was made.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the registered  
2 voters of the city of Woburn at its next biennial municipal  
3 election in the form of the following question which shall be  
4 placed upon the official ballot to be used at said election:—  
5 "Shall an act passed by the general court in the year nineteen

6 hundred and sixty-four, entitled 'An Act providing for the  
 7 reorganization of the recreation commission in the city of  
 8 Woburn', be accepted?" If a majority of the voters voting  
 9 thereon vote in the affirmative in answer to said question, then  
 10 this act shall thereupon take full effect in said city, but not  
 11 otherwise.
