AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXTENDING THE WALL ALONG THE LYNN BEACH
BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 609 of the acts of 1963 is hereby amended by adding
2 at the end the following sentence:— The work authorized by
3 this act shall not commence prior to May first, nineteen hundred
4 and sixty-four.

THE COMPENSATION OF JUDGES

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ACT APPROVED MARCH TWENTY-NINE LAST.

Section 1. That the compensation of the judges of the Supreme Court of this State shall be fixed at the sum of \$10,000 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$2,500 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 2. That the compensation of the judges of the District Court shall be fixed at the sum of \$5,000 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,250 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 3. That the compensation of the judges of the County Court shall be fixed at the sum of \$3,000 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$750 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 4. That the compensation of the judges of the Probate Court shall be fixed at the sum of \$2,000 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$500 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 5. That the compensation of the judges of the Circuit Court shall be fixed at the sum of \$4,000 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,000 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 6. That the compensation of the judges of the Municipal Court shall be fixed at the sum of \$1,500 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$375 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 7. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of Appeals shall be fixed at the sum of \$8,000 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$2,000 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 8. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of Sessions shall be fixed at the sum of \$6,000 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,500 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 9. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of Common Pleas shall be fixed at the sum of \$4,500 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,125 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 10. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of Chancery shall be fixed at the sum of \$7,000 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,750 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 11. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of Admiralty shall be fixed at the sum of \$5,500 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,375 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 12. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of Exchequer shall be fixed at the sum of \$4,000 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,000 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 13. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of King's Bench shall be fixed at the sum of \$6,500 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,625 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 14. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of Queen's Bench shall be fixed at the sum of \$5,000 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,250 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 15. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of Common Pleas shall be fixed at the sum of \$4,500 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,125 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 16. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of Chancery shall be fixed at the sum of \$7,000 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,750 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 17. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of Admiralty shall be fixed at the sum of \$5,500 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,375 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 18. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of Exchequer shall be fixed at the sum of \$4,000 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,000 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 19. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of King's Bench shall be fixed at the sum of \$6,500 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,625 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

Section 20. That the compensation of the judges of the Court of Queen's Bench shall be fixed at the sum of \$5,000 per annum, payable in four equal installments of \$1,250 each, on the 1st day of January, 1st day of April, 1st day of July, and 1st day of October, in each year, and the same shall be paid out of the State Treasury.
