1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 two members of the senate, three members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
5 and study relative to the billing and accounting practices of the
6 New England Telephone and Telegraph Company with particu-
7 lar reference to furnishing its consumers with detailed informa-
8 tion on charges for toll calls and other charges when so requested
9 by the consumers.
