- 4 nation of the world to give official recognition to said State of
- 5 Israel; and
- 6 *Whereas*, The State of Israel is a fellow Democracy and a
- 7 bulwark of strength to the free world in the Middle East; there-
- 8 fore be it
- 9 *Resolved*, That the general court of the commonwealth of
- 10 Massachusetts extend its greetings and best wishes to the State
- 11 of Israel upon the sixteenth anniversary of the State of Israel;
- 12 and be it further
- 13 *Resolved*, That a copy of these resolutions be forwarded by
- 14 the secretary of the commonwealth to the State of Israel.
