By Messrs. Nazzaro of Boston and Langone of Boston, petition of Michael A. Nazzaro, Jr., and Joseph A. Langone, 3rd, that official ballots in primaries and elections be required to designate candidates by number in the order in which candidates for the same office have been officially determined for appearance on said ballot. Election Laws.

AN ACT REQUIRING THAT OFFICIAL BALLOT IN ALL MUNICIPAL AND STATE PRIMARIES AND ELECTIONS SHALL DESIGNATE THEREON THE CANDIDATE FOR EACH OFFICE BY A NUMBER WHICH SHALL BE IN ACCORD WITH THE SEQUENCE OF THE ORDER IN WHICH ALL CANDIDATES FOR THE SAME OFFICE HAS BEEN OFFICIALLY DETERMINED FOR APPEARANCE ON THE SAID BALLOT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the official
2 ballot used in all municipal and state primaries and elections
3 shall designate the candidate for each office by a number which
4 shall be in accord with the sequence of the order in which all
5 candidates for the same office has been determined for appear-
6 ance on the said ballot.
