AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF CENTRAL MIDDLESEX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

3 the acts of 1962, is hereby further amended by striking out
