AN ACT EXTENDING THE EXEMPTION OF EXCISE TAX ON MOTOR VEHICLES OF CERTAIN VETERANS AND PERSONS WHO HAVE SUFFERED LOSS OF OR LOSS OF USE OF BOTH LEGS.
