AN ACT CHANGING THE TIME LIMIT FOR THE COMMITMENT OF A DEFENDANT FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBSERVATION IN A CAPITAL CASE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 105 of chapter 123 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by section 2 of chapter 101 of the acts of 1961,
3 is hereby further amended by inserting in the first sentence after
4 the words "not later than thirty-five days thereafter", the fol-
5 lowing words: — except in capital cases in which it shall be not
6 later than sixty days thereafter.
