## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE STATE EMPLOYEES' GROUP INSURANCE COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE AMOUNT OF GROUP LIFE INSURANCE AND THE AMOUNT OF GROUP ACCIDENTAL DEATH AND DISBURSEMENT INSURANCE UPON RETIREMENT OF EMPLOYEES UNDER THE CONTRIBUTORY GROUP GENERAL OR BLANKET INSURANCE FOR PERSONS IN THE SERVICE OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved,* That the state employees' group insurance com-  
2 mission is hereby authorized and directed to make an investi-  
3 gation and study of the subject matter of current house document  
4 numbered 1128, relative to the amount of group life insurance  
5 and the amount of group accidental death and dismemberment  
6 insurance upon retirement of employees under the contributory  
7 group general or blanket insurance for persons in the service of  
8 the commonwealth. Said commission shall report to the general  
9 court the results of its investigation and study and its recom-  
10 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary  
11 to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing the same with  
12 the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the last  
13 Wednesday of December in the current year.
