AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BUILDING INSPECTOR OF THE TOWN OF WINTHROP TO ISSUE A PERMIT TO THE WINTHROP HOUSING AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT A MULTIPLE UNIT HOUSING PROJECT FOR THE ELDERLY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter forty A
2 and chapter one hundred and forty-five of the General Laws, the
3 building inspector of the town of Winthrop shall issue a permit
4 to the Winthrop Housing Authority to construct a multiple unit
5 housing project for the elderly on land in said town known as
6 the Circle Street site, shown on a plan entitled "Plan of Land in
7 Winthrop, Massachusetts" by Whitman & Howard, Engineers,
8 dated November, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine; and being
9 more specifically described as Lots, thirty-three, thirty-four,
10 thirty-five, thirty-six and thirty-seven, and the area known as
11 Circle Street on said Plan, being further described on a Plan
12 entitled, "Plan of Lots in Winthrop, Massachusetts, owned by
13 O. E. Lewis." H. T. Whitman and Channing Howard, Sur-
14 veyors, recorded in Suffolk Registry of Deeds, Book two thou-
15 sand six hundred and fifty-eight, Page two hundred and twenty-
16 eight, containing a total area of sixty-five thousand, five hundred
17 and forty-six square feet, more or less.

1 SECTION 2. The articles with reference to this act, provided in
2 the warrant for the town meetings of Winthrop are hereby vali-
3 dated and any action taken by the town of Winthrop at its
4 annual or special town meetings in the current year shall be
5 validated and effective as if this act were in effect at the time
6 when the warrants for such annual or special town meetings were
7 issued. This act shall take effect upon the acceptance of the
8 articles provided in the warrant for the annual or special town
9 meetings of the town of Winthrop in the current year, but not
10 otherwise.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
