REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON GOVERNMENT
IN RESPONSE TO A RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
ON APRIL 10, 1958

The Committee on Government has the honor to report to the House of Representatives the results of its study of the subject of the organization and operation of the Executive Branch of the Federal Government. The Committee's report is based on a series of public hearings held during the past year, and on a study of the various agencies and departments of the Executive Branch.

The Committee believes that the present organization of the Executive Branch is generally sound, but that certain changes are needed to improve its efficiency and to better coordinate the activities of the various agencies and departments. The Committee's recommendations are set forth in the accompanying report.
