RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO RESTRICTIONS UPON LAND AVAILABLE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SINGLE FAMILY DWELLINGS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 two members of the senate, three members of the house of rep-
3 resentatives, the commissioner of commerce or his designee, the
4 president of the Federation of Planning Boards of Massachu-
5 setts or his designee, the counsel for the Massachusetts Select-
6 men's Association, the president of the Massachusetts Home
7 Builders Association or his designee, and four persons to be ap-
8 pointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose
9 of making an investigation and study of the subject matter of
10 current senate document numbered 276, relative to restrictions
11 upon land available for the construction of single family dwell-
12 ings.
